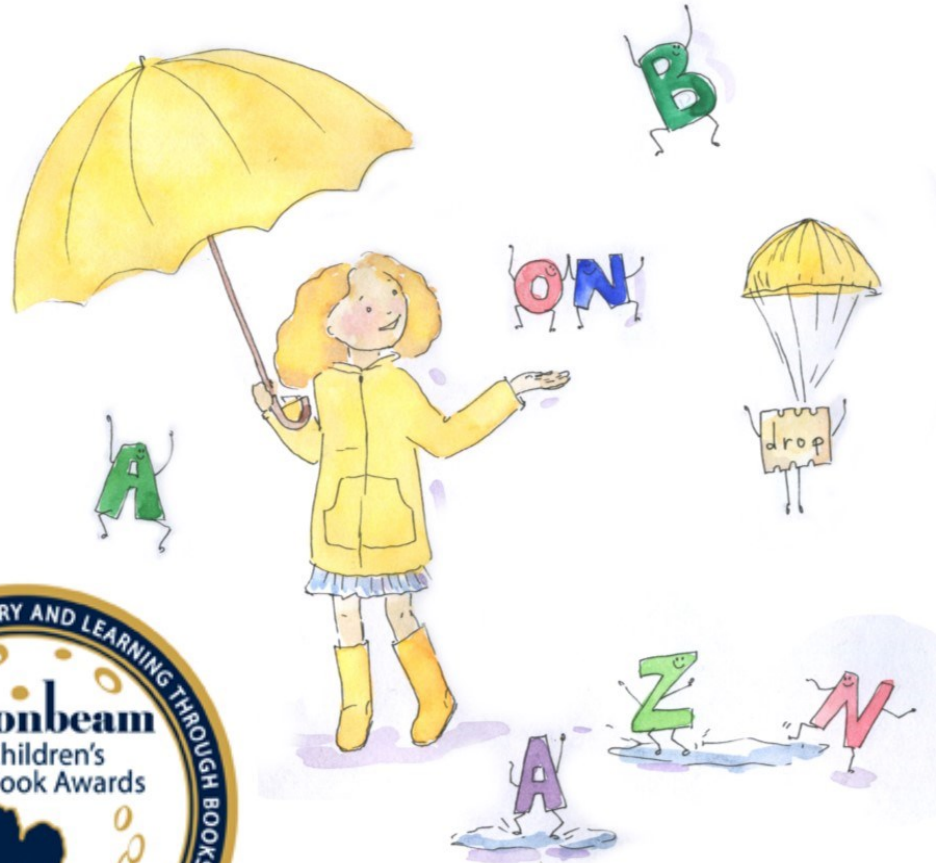

inside each one of all of us!





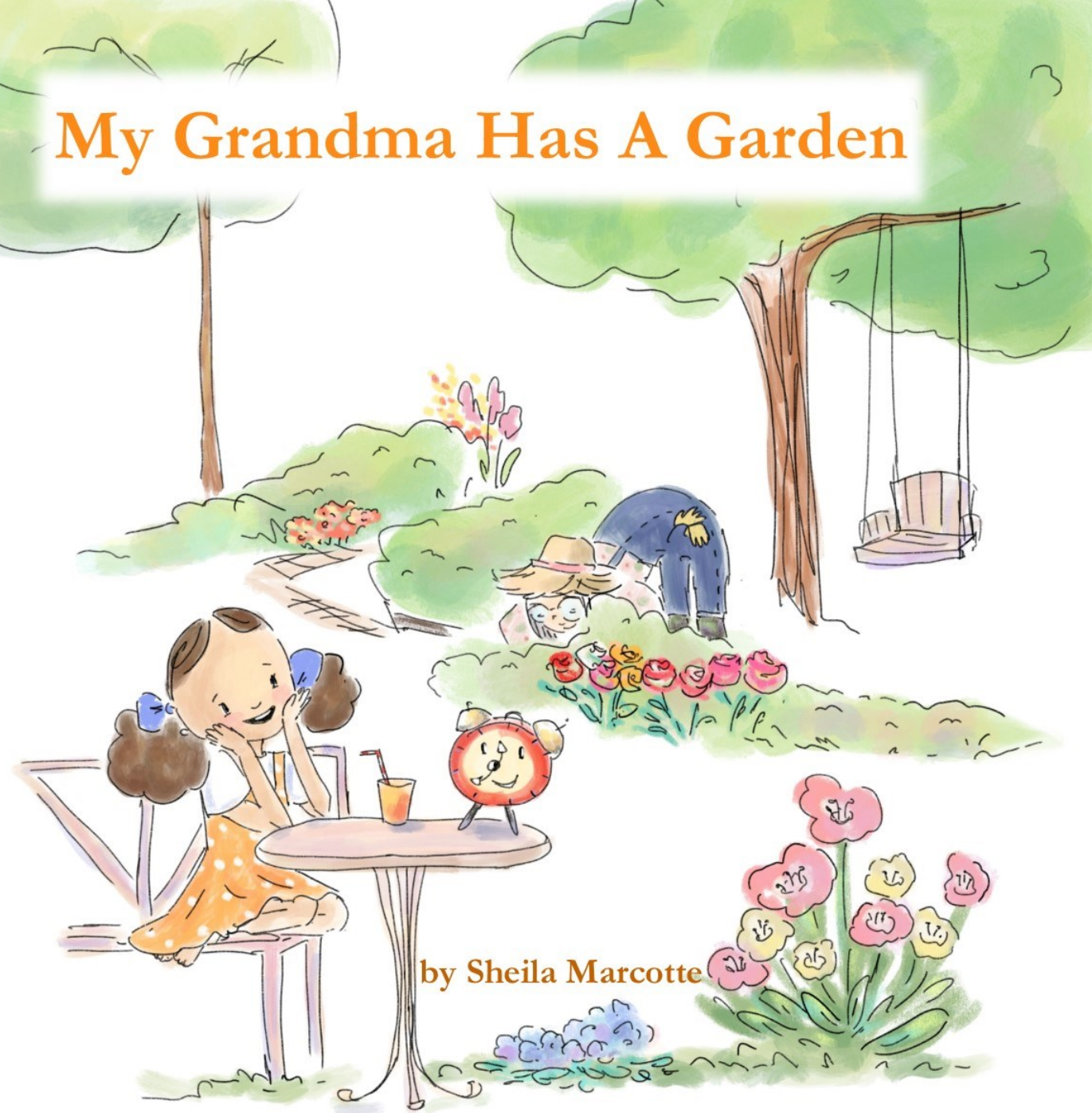

...and foolish paranoia,

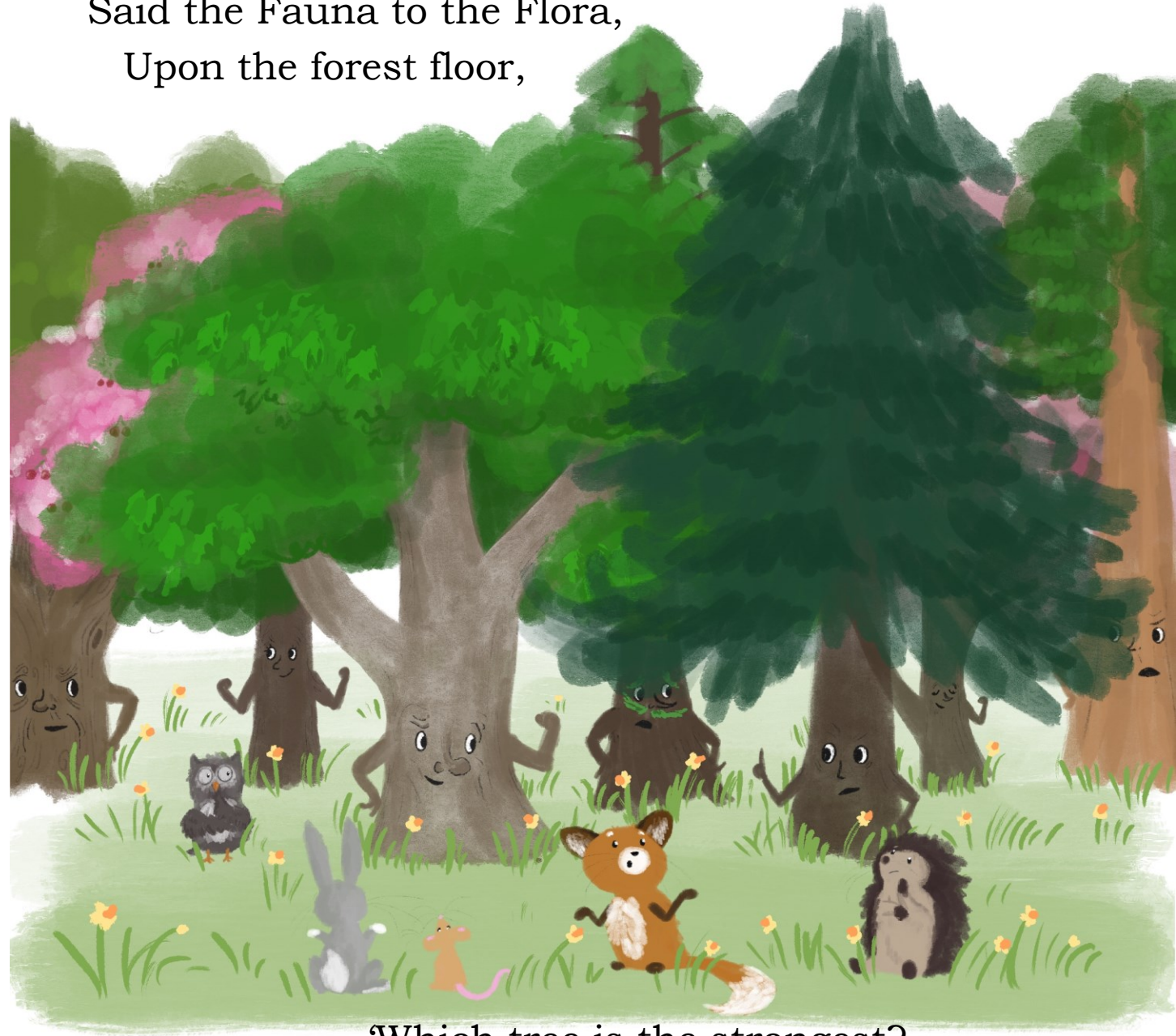


**The Sequoia thinks

Like moths and ants and worms or slugs,

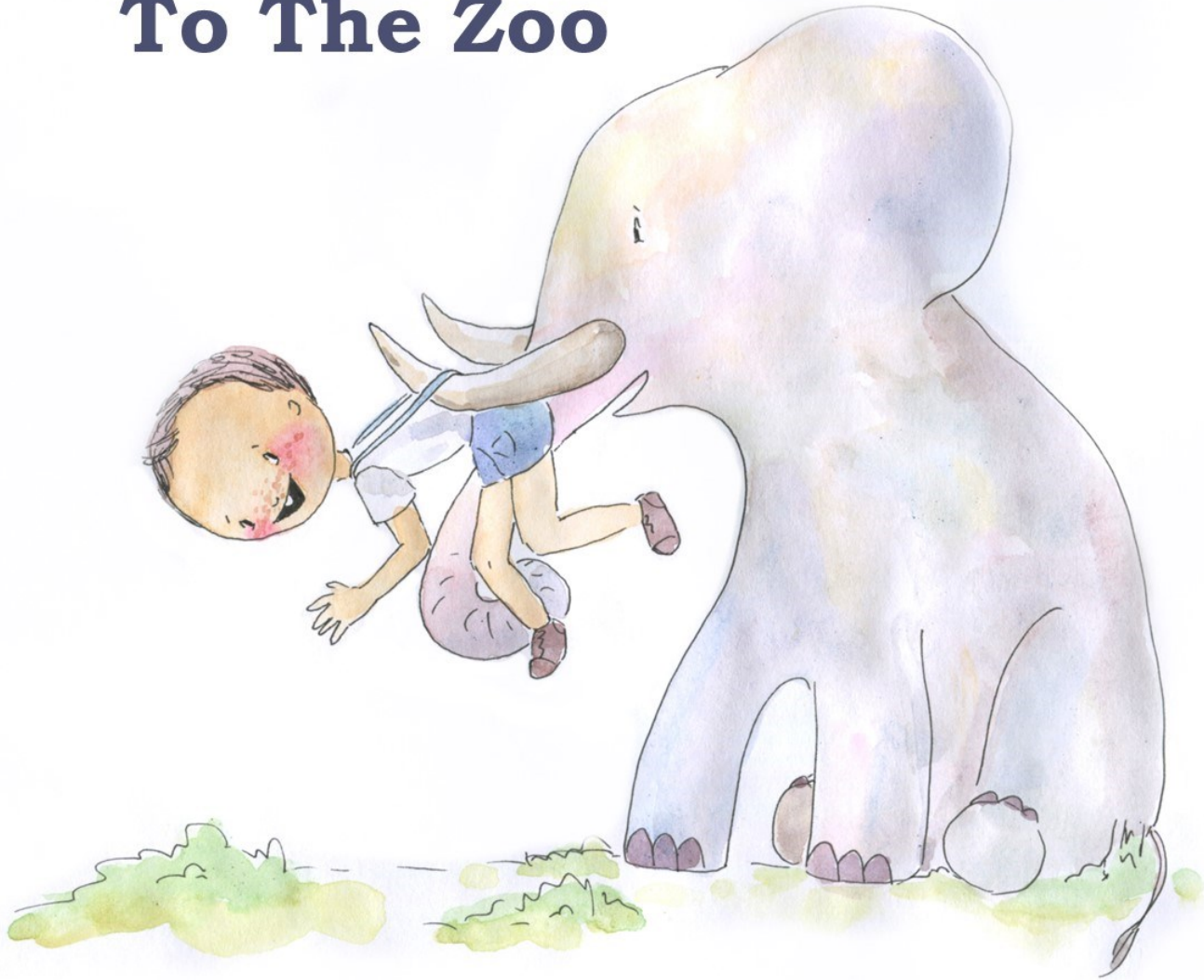

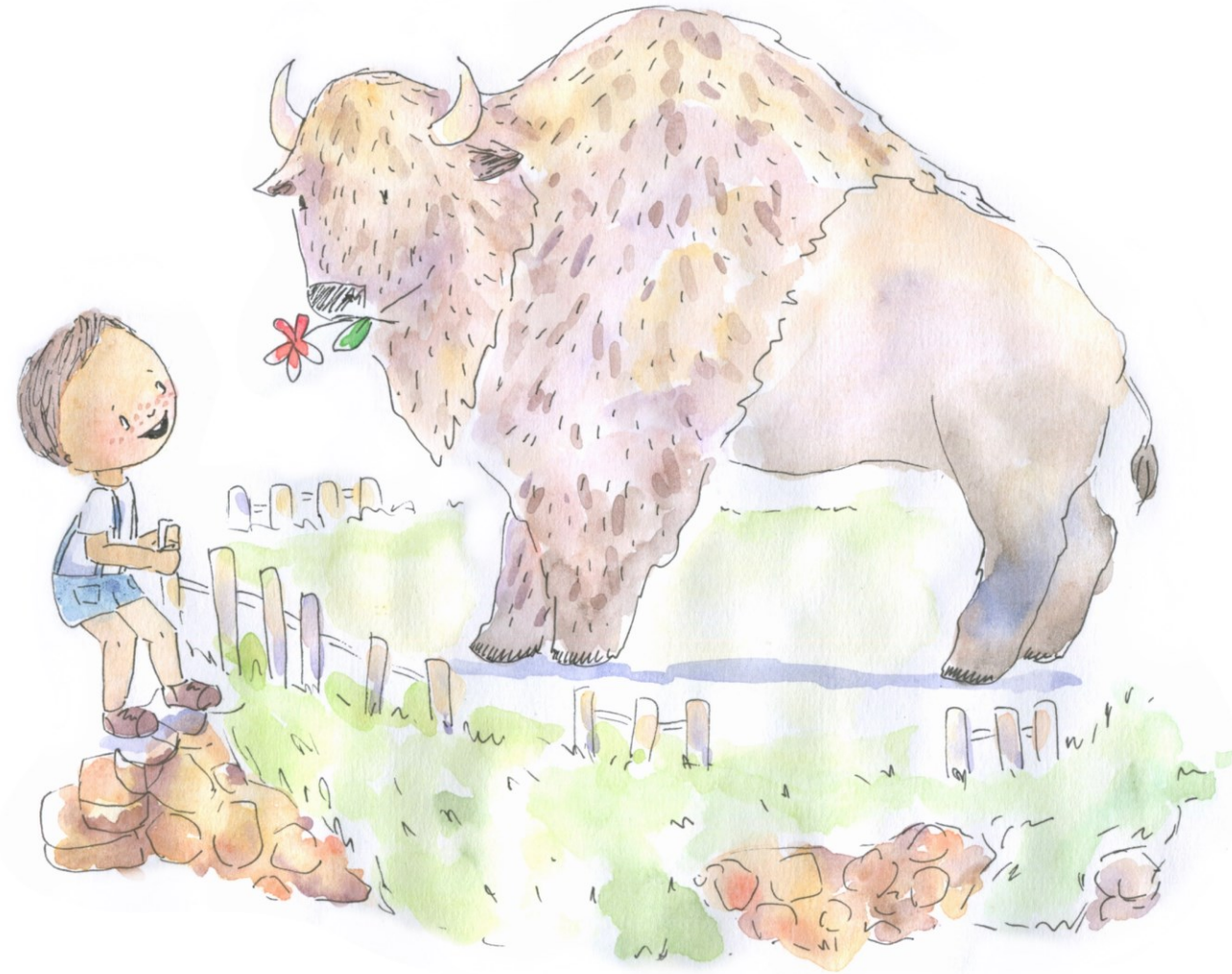
