


"The lady was less than happy about the pet mishap, but Tess has a great story to share in Golden Tales


Tess finding it great fun to run withor after- a beach jogger!


Chasing **Nightmares** is a riveting and wellwritten story about two girls who have grown up together and share a dream.



All the magic begins when the girls are raised in an orphanage!






They share a common bond.

The girls run into some trouble, it seems someone's trying to kill them!




Through many stressful situations, the girls begin to unravel the truth about their past and the mother did not know.
